Samancta is designed to harmonise procedures for samples taking, provides constructive guidance to customs officers on the sampling methods, address health and safety issues. The benefits of using Samancta are to maintain a **high level of quality and consistency in the samples taken**, ensure every sample meets the requirements for official testing purposes, **create a standard approach for the labelling**, **storage and transportation of samples**, and ensure the chain of evidence is not broken as everyone follows the same sampling plan.

The course takes 1.5 hours.


Available languages
