Imported and exported goods must be declared under specific subheadings or subdivisions of the Combined Nomenclature or of other nomenclatures they fall under, via the Classification Information System (CLASS). This determines the rate of customs duty of the Common Customs Tariff, or which non-tariff measures apply.

The easy-to-use eLearning course **CLASS System** is based on the Union Customs Code and is produced by the European Commission Directorate General for Taxation and Customs (TAXUD) under the Customs Programme.

Scope

This course guides you through the **CLASS system**, the single access point to different types of information on **goods classification**, regardless of its nature, ensuring the **transparency of all classification-related information**.

Upon completion of the course, you will be able to confidently **use the CLASS system**.

Audience


- Traders who want to import or export goods and need to find the correct Combined Nomenclature or other nomenclature these goods fall under.

The course takes less than 30 minutes to complete.


Available languages
