ICS2 Process and Data:

The EU's advance cargo information system "Import Control System 2 (ICS2)" supports the implementation of the EU customs safety and security regulatory regime aimed to better protect single market and EU citizens. It collects data about all goods entering or transiting or transhipping the EU territory prior to their arrival through the ENS.

This is an eLearning module based on the **Union Customs Code** and produced by the **European Commission** under the **Customs Programme**.


The time required to complete the course is around **2 hours**.
