Customs procedures are the set of managements and operations related to imports or exports of goods to and from the EU, as these are defined by the *Union Customs Code (UCC)*.

To benefit fully from the course and to achieve the learning outcomes, it is recommended to integrate it in your own training programme and develop a blended learning strategy.


Features

Sctions 2, 3 and 4 explain when a customs debt will be incurred, who will be the debtor(s) and where the customs debtor is incurred.

While sections 5, 6 and 7 explain the procedures how a customs debt is established and recovered or remitted and repaid.

Course duration


The course takes around 75 minutes to complete.
