Customs procedures are the set of managements and operations related to imports or exports of goods to and from the EU, as these are defined by the *Union Customs Code (UCC)*.

- what can happen with an authorisation after it has been granted and how it should be monitored in a standard process;
- where the other procedures deviate from the standard process.

The first part of this course focuses on the standard process applied to Customs Decisions. Other processes deviating from the standard process are presented at the end.


