# **Customs status of goods**

Customs procedures are the set of managements and operations related to imports or exports of goods to and from the EU, as these are defined by the *Union Customs Code (UCC)*.

The easy-to-use eLearning course **Customs status of goods** is based on the Union Customs Code and is produced by the European Commission Directorate General for Taxation and Customs (TAXUD) under the Customs 2020 Programme.

# Scope

It provides **fundamental knowledge** in the domain of customs status of goods and the **related procedures** as defined by the **Union Customs Code** (**UCC**).

**Customs professionals** in both the public and private sector who in the course of their activities need to know about the customs status of goods.



# **Learning Outcomes**

By the end of this 85-minute course, you will have learned about:

- the customs status of goods as Union or non-Union goods;
- the concept of Proof of Union Status (PoUS) as well as the different means:
- the possible changes of the customs status of goods;
- how an economic operator can request a PoUS, and which steps an authorised issuer should follow:
- · the use of a PoUS.

To benefit fully from the course and to achieve the learning outcomes, it is recommended to integrate it in your own training programme and develop a blended learning strategy.

#### **Features**

After giving a definition of the customs status of goods and explaining the difference between Union goods and non-Union goods (section 2 and 3), the course presents the different means to prove the customs status of Unions goods (section 4) and concludes with the procedures related to the PoUS (section 5 and 6).

#### **Course duration**


