Customs procedures are the set of managements and operations related to imports or exports of goods to and from the EU, as these are defined by the *Union Customs Code (UCC)*.



Scope

It provides **fundamental knowledge** in the domain of customs valuation as defined by the **Union Customs Code (UCC)**.

Customs professionals in the public and private sector who need to understand the principles of customs valuation for goods entering the customs territory of the Union.

By the end of this 60-minute course, you will have learned about:

- The legal basis for establishing the customs value of goods;
- The 6 methods to determine customs value:
- The primary and alternative methods of valuation and when to apply them;
- The mandatory and optional adjustments to the transaction value.

Features

This course describes the methods that can be applied to determine the customs value: the primary method and the secondary methods. Each customs value method is explained in three parts: the calculation, the conditions to be fulfilled and an example. The different methods of valuation are easily accessible via the menu of the course.

You may interrupt your course. When reopening the course, you can resume where you left off. The completed sections are indicated in yellow in the menu. A course summary of the most relevant information is made available in a printable format in the course library



Course duration


The course takes around 60 minutes to complete.
