Entry of goods and Temporary storage Leading for results. Learning for purpose.

Customs procedures are the set of managements and operations related to imports or exports of goods to and from the EU, as these are defined by the **Union Customs Code (UCC)**.

The easy-to-use eLearning course **Entry of goods and Temporary storage** is based on the Union Customs Code and is produced by the European Commission Directorate General for Taxation and Customs (TAXUD) under the Customs 2020 Programme.

Scope

The eLearning course provides **fundamental knowledge** in the domain of entry of goods and temporary storage and the **related procedures** as defined by the **Union Customs Code (UCC)**.

Audience

Customs officials and **economic operators** playing a role in the process of bringing non-Union goods into the customs territory of the European Union.

By the end of this 90-minute course, you will have learned about:

- the concept of entry of goods;
- the process of arrival of goods;
- what presentation of goods is;
- the concept of temporary storage.

To benefit fully from the course and to achieve the learning outcomes, it is recommended to integrate it in your own training programme and develop a blended learning strategy.


Features

As non-Union goods are automatically placed under temporary storage when entering the customs territory of the Union, this course deals with both the entry of goods (sections 2, 3 and 4) and the temporary storage (section 5).

You may however access the section of your interest by navigating through the menu.

Course duration


The course takes around 90 minutes to complete.
