VAT Obligations course covers the question: "What are the obligations you need to observe when carrying out an economic activity?"

The easy-to-use eLearning course **VAT Obligations** is based on the VAT directive and is produced by the European Commission Directorate General for Taxation and Customs (TAXUD) under the Fiscalis 2020 Programme.

Scope

- Taxable person will need to observe a number of obligations set out in the VAT Directive whether that person is liable for payment or not.
- A system is put in place allowing for Member States to **collaborate** and **control** VAT across the EU.

Audience

The course is aimed at officials in EU countries, and more generally, anyone with a particular interest in VAT wanting to get basic knowledge of the VAT directive.

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Learning Outcomes

By the end of this course, you will understand:

- the obligations that taxable persons and certain non-taxable persons need to respect:
 - obligation to pay
 - \circ appointment of tax representative
 - payment arrangements
 - \circ identification
 - \circ invoicing
 - o accounting
 - o **returns**
 - recapitulative statements
- the importance of the Value added tax Information Exchange System in the Single Market (VIES).

To benefit fully from the course and to achieve the learning outcomes, it is recommended to integrate it in your own training programme and develop a blended learning strategy.
