ICS2 Process and Data: Rail

The EU's advance cargo information system “**Import Control System 2 (ICS2)**” supports the implementation of the EU customs **safety** and **security** regulatory regime aimed to better protect single market and EU citizens. It **collects data** about all goods entering or transiting or transhipping the EU territory **prior to their arrival** through the **ENS**. This is an eLearning module based on the **Union Customs Code** and produced by the **European Commission** under the **Customs Programme**.

Audience

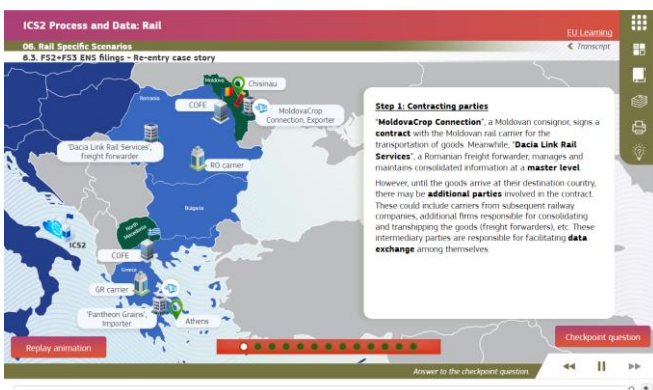
This eLearning module is addressed to **economic operators** dealing with the ICS2 process for **rail** transportation.

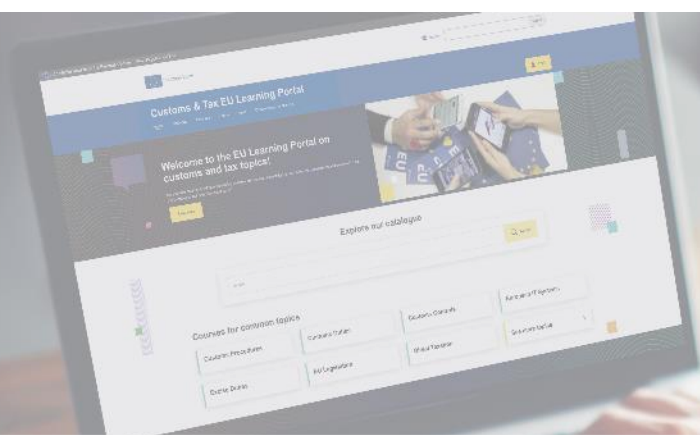
